6. OFFICIATING REPORT

Well the 2022 Sydney Hockey Season is quickly coming to an end. Between COVID, Flu, reliance on playing Umpires, the Draw and support to other Hockey Organisations within NSW it has been a challenging season. On the top of the list I would place the Draw. The current Draw has three, not two or four teams in Premier League. The draw exacerbates this situation as there is no alignment between the draw and the way Sydney Hockey Officiating appoints or grades Umpires.

Sydney Hockey Officiating grades its Umpires PL1. PL2, PL3, SL1/2 and SL3 to 7. Unfortunately the draw often has SL7 followed SL1 making it very hard to appoint resources to achieve maximum utilisation and efficiency. Also whilst it is generally acknowledged that Sydney Hockey is the number one provider of Umpires and Officials to Hockey NSW and Masters Championships, the recent deferment of games has highlighted that Sydney Hockey Umpires umpire the SWL Competition and local Association Competitions of North West Sydney and SEHA. Perhaps our catch cry should be "We train them, you use them you". Attached please find a copy of our efficiency report year to date..

The Sydney Hockey Walking Out Apparel has now been received and distributed as has the Technical Official's Teal Blue Shirts and the Premier League Pink Umpire Shirts. An order has now been placed for new Sydney League Yellow Umpire Shirts and it is hoped that they might arrive in time for the final series. All items have been gratefully received and appreciated.

Finally I am seeking approval to purchase a further 25 Pink Umpire Shirts. Attached in support of this request is a copy of the Pink shirt management plan that outlines who has received and still requires a Pink Umpire Shirt.
