5. 2021 ANNUAL REPORTS

Presidents Report – Presented by Peter Busch and as appears in the Annual Report. Peter also reviewed the year much like the previous season, with the outlook now for 2022 looking bright. Peter was appreciative for the clubs who had recruited additional players that saw 100 teams nominated for 2021, it was also noted the co-operation with SWHL in producing a joint statement to unfortunately cancel the season. While the Covid-19 pandemic did interrupt the season, Peter was hopefully that clubs were able to access NSW Govt financial assistance. Peter mentioned our aim to make better use of technology and touched on Live Streaming (to be covered later in the meeting). Peter expressed his appreciation for the application applied to the task by Peter Hayes (EO), Bruce Cook (Officiating) and contribution made by the Board members during the year. Majority of monthly meeting were by Zoom and while there was robust discussion the board is working towards a complete and improved competition for 2022.

Finance Report – Rohan McCoy presented the Finance Report/Statement. (as shown in the Annual Report). Rohan explained the process behind granting refunds of 46-48% of fees collected, due to the abandonment of the season at the end of June. Rohan noted that SH qualified for grants from the Government due to Covid related disruptions.
