PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2013 Was again a very active and successful season (both on and off the field) for the Sydney Hockey Association. Given the challenging economic times that has had an impact on our sport over the past few years, I am pleased to report that hockey in Sydney continues to move ahead in terms of the strategic direction that was set by the new Board elected in late 2011.

The ongoing pressures being experienced to survive, maintain and grow by all Clubs on an annual basis with its dedicated but diminishing band of volunteers is well understood by the Board. In view of this, a special strategic emphasis on working closely with the Clubs for the targeted recruitment, retention and development of administrators, officials, coaches, volunteers and players must be a high priority during the next 3 years (2014-16).

Hopefully, this will specifically include the centralisation of competitions for men, women, juniors, indoor and masters and involve a full time Executive Officer and Development Officer for Sydney Hockey.

Notwithstanding the present challenges for hockey, the Board of Management and its various Competition Committees were able to build on many of the new initiatives that were successfully introduced in 2012 to ensure that the positive structural changes already delivered can be further developed for the future benefit of all the hockey stakeholders in Sydney.

Some of the 2013 initiatives include -

- Special Working Groups established to review the Competition Structure and By Laws the results from these reviews will be introduced for 2014 season
- Fair Play across all competitions a strong message was delivered to all Clubs in late 2011 to reduce Judiciary matters. This resulted in 2012 having the lowest level of suspensions for the past 22 years. 2013 was again marginally better, therefore all members expectations should be that they can participate in hockey in Sydney in a competitive, enjoyable and safe environment.
- Communications further development of the website for statistical records in the Premier League and Sydney Cup competitions was introduced on a pilot basis. The results were excellent and therefore all Divisions will be undertaken for the 2014 season. The social media communication network participation continues to be very active and again this will be further developed for 2014.
- Representative teams stylish new playing and after match uniforms were introduced for the 2013 NSW Championships. This was matched by the great results with both teams being crowned 2013 NSW Champions to again back up the 2012 results of joint Champions.
- The Officiating Group continues to grow with additional umpires and technical officials being accredited in 2013. This has allowed umpires to be appointed throughout all Divisions this season.
- Annual Presentation a new approach (supported by the Clubs) was taken for the annual presentation and awards dinner this year. Overall a very positive result was delivered and this approach was supported by many for continuation in future years.
- SHA Honour Boards have been completed and are on show in the Waratah Room at the Sydney Olympic Hockey Centre. The SHA Executive Office Bearers, Life Members and Hall of Fame members are recorded in well presented Honour Boards this project was initiated by the Board in 2012.

In conclusion, I would like to take this opportunity to again formally recognise and thank all the many dedicated and committed members of our great Sydney Hockey Community – from Board and Committee Members, Club Administrators, Players, Umpires, Officials and Volunteers who give up their valuable personal time so that many others are able to enjoy their weekly hockey experiences, both on and off the field in Sydney.

I look forward to seeing you all again in 2014 as Sydney Hockey continues to evolve whilst still being recognised as the premier Hockey Association in NSW and Australia.

FINANCE REPORT

THE 2013 financial year saw my initial foray into the control and reporting of financial results for the association. This transition was greatly assisted by the combined support of the Board of Management, Club Officials and staff of the Hockey NSW. I give thanks for their clear communication, co-operation, patience (when required) and sound advice during the course of the year.

The year's result reinforced the association's strong financial position maintaining substantial cash reserves accumulated through the legacy and foresight of past operations.

The association remains strongly positioned for the ongoing conduct and viability of hockey in Sydney, with the fiscal resources to support stakeholders in a committed partnership developing Sydney hockey for 2014 and beyond.

Key Operational Financial Highlights for 2013:

- Adoption of a simplified club fee invoicing methodology,
- Setup of a regular payroll system for payments to umpires and officials,
- Established a fee reward system for provision of "Club Umpires".

The financial operations of the association are to uphold and be governed by the principles of service and transparency to all stakeholders of the organisation. These stakeholders are all those involved in the game of hockey, be they players, club officials or umpires and technical officers.

The overall financial performance of the Sydney Hockey Association for the 2013 season was very much in line with projections and expectations. The total activities of the Association of \$536,588 generated an **operating surplus of \$6,710** for the year ended 30 September 2013, compared to the profit forecast projected of \$5, 350

The details of variances against the financial projections are:

- A favourable variance from income received of \$14,988 comprising
 - Club Revenues \$ 4,265 (under forecast 1 less team)
 - Development \$ 4,890 (under forecast)
 - Interest Received \$ 3,951 (under forecast)
 - HNSW Fees \$29,460 (over forecast contra item)
- A negative net variance in expenses of \$13,628 was recorded which relates to items as follows
 - Venue / Field Hire \$21,122 (under forecast)
 - Development \$ 8,790 (under forecast)
 - Presentation Night \$4,500 (over forecast)
 - Officiating \$ 2,962 (over forecast)
 - HNSW Fees \$29,460 (over forecast contra item)

The Association currently has a total of **\$150,000** on term deposit with the National Australia Bank. This is in addition to the funds in the operating account of **\$35,461**.

At 30 September 2013, the Association had **net assets of \$231,156** (an increase of \$6,710 from the previous year which represents the operating surplus for 2013). This provides a sound financial position for the ongoing conduct of hockey in Sydney and to appropriately support the Clubs and their players in a committed partnership for the future development of Sydney Hockey for 2014 and beyond.

I commend to you the financial report of the association for the 2013 Financial Year. I trust that it meets our standards of governance and that throughout the year the financial operations of the association achieved or exceeded those standards.

Note 1: Statement of Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act New South Wales. The committee has determined that the association is not a

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

a) Income Tax

No provision for income tax has been raised as the entity is exempt from income tax under Section 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

b) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

c) Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

The depreciable amount of all PPE is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held

Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the

d) Impairment of Assets

At each reporting date, the entity reviews the carrying values of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have been impaired. If such an indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs to sell and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying value. Any excess of the asset's carrying value over its recoverable amount is expensed to the income statement.

e) Employee Benefits

Provision is made for the association's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. Employee benefits have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled.

f) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

g) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at-call with banks, other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

1 Statement of Accounting Policies (continued)

h) Revenue and Other Income

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest rate method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.

Grant and donation income is recognised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

i) Leases

Leases of PPE, where substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to the ownership of the asset, but not the legal ownership, are transferred to the association, are classified as finance leases.

Finance leases are capitalised by recording an asset and a liability at the lower of the amounts equal to the fair value of the leased property or the present value of the minimum lease payments. Including any guaranteed residual values. Lease payments are allocated between the reduction of the lease liability and the lease interest expense for that period.

Leased assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis over the shorter of their estimated useful lives or the lease term.

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the periods in which they are incurred.

j) Goods and Services Tax

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with other receivables or payables in the statement of financial position.

Cash flows are presented in the cash flow statement on a gross basis, except for the GST component of investing and financing activities, which are disclosed as operating cash flows.

k) Comparative Figures

When required by Accounting Standards, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform to changes in presentation for the current financial year.
