The live streaming of a full season of action from Premier League 1 and 2, free to view and accessible all around the country on Facebook and YouTube and around the world on the FIH Watch Hockey app was truly ground-breaking. We attracted many viewers from all around, generated discussion and interest, as well as hopefully exposing our great game to a new audience. We also had a much greater social media presence this year and this generated much interest and conversation. Thank you to David Moore for his amazing work in this area and his commentary across the live streaming was top drawer.

The number of teams competing remained stable post COVID, which was very pleasing, and we also welcomed a new club, Sydney Lions to the fold. As we continue to move out of the pandemic time period, I am hopeful that any players who left the game during COVID will return as life resumes some semblance of normality. I encourage all players and clubs to be proactive in the recruitment of new players and to create an inclusive club-based culture where all people feel welcome. Strong, inclusive clubs that are well managed, inclusive, and transparent are the keys for growing the game and attracting new participants. The Sydney League competition was competitive across all grades and continues to be the bedrock of Sydney Hockey.

Thank you to all of our officials who helped us run the competition this year. Thanks to the hard work of our Officiating Committee, led so well by Bruce Cook, well over 95% of our games had official umpires appointed. We still need to increase the number of officials, especially amongst our younger players. It's a great way to subsidise your education and make a difference. Having watched many games this year, almost every player seems to be a very knowledgeable umpire and is able to vocalise this pretty regularly! Maybe it's time to put a whistle in those mouths!! A big thank you to our hard working Board. It's certainly not a glamorous role, but important nonetheless and each member gives of their time freely and does so with the best interest of the game at heart.

At Sydney Hockey all of our meetings are open for members to attend, ask questions and provide feedback, we will certainly continue this into the new year.

After our first full year in a while, the future continues to be bright for hockey in Sydney. Note 1: Statement of Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act New South Wales. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

a) Income Tax

No provision for income tax has been raised as the entity is exempt from income tax under Section 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

b) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

c) Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

The depreciable amount of all PPE is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

d) Impairment of Assets

At each reporting date, the entity reviews the carrying values of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have been impaired. If such an indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs to sell and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying value. Any excess of the asset's carrying value over its recoverable amount is expensed to the income statement.

e) Employee Benefits

Provision is made for the association's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. Employee benefits have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled.

f) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

g) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at-call with banks, other shortterm highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less. Sydney Hockey Association Inc. Notes to the financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2022

1 Statement of Accounting Policies (continued)

h) Revenue and Other Income

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest rate method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.

Grant and donation income is recognised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

Leases

Leases of PPE, where substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to the ownership of the asset, but not the legal ownership, are transferred to the association, are classified as finance leases.

Finance leases are capitalised by recording an asset and a liability at the lower of the amounts equal to the fair value of the leased property or the present value of the minimum lease payments. Including any guaranteed residual values. Lease payments are allocated between the reduction of the lease liability and the lease interest expense for that period.

Leased assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis over the shorter of their estimated useful lives or the lease term.

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the periods in which they are incurred.

j) Goods and Services Tax

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with other receivables or payables in the statement of financial position.

Cash flows are presented in the cash flow statement on a gross basis, except for the GST component of investing and financing activities, which are disclosed as operating cash flows.

k) Comparative Figures

When required by Accounting Standards, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform to changes in presentation for the current financial year.
