Each game was hard fought, and congratulations to all of the major premiers across the grades. Similarly, the grand finals in the Sydney Leagues produced some exciting games and were a fitting conclusion to the season.

The Sydney Hockey Presentation Night was again very well attended and provided a fitting finale to the season. It is always a great honour for Sydney Hockey to welcome Brian Booth to present the medal named in his honour. He has a keen interest in the game and hopefully we will see him back presenting his medal for many years to come. Congratulations to Dylan Martin from the University of NSW Hockey Club on winning his first Brian Booth Medal. A tremendous achievement.

The effective operation of such a large competition is not an easy process. There are many people who work tirelessly to provide a quality hockey experience for an increasing number of players this season. Our Executive Officer, Peter Hayes, does an outstanding job in the coordination and smooth running of the competition in all grades. His dedication and commitment to the game of hockey is unmatched and he regularly goes above and beyond to make life a bit easier for all clubs and players.

To Bruce Cook, SH Vice-President and chair of the Officiating Committee and Robbie Sutton for their commitment and dedication to providing umpires to all grades in the competition. This year the Officiating Committee was able to have badged umpires at over 95% of games across all grades, truly a great achievement. Rohan McCoy, our Financial Director deserves specific mention for his diligence in keeping the costs of playing the game to a minimum. SH is very aware of the need to closely monitor and manage the cost of playing and seeks at all times to make the game accessible to all who wish to play. Thank you to Corrine Rochester, Alan O'Connell and Ken Campbell for the hours of dedication they give as Board members.

The season was successful, though it wasn't without its challenges. The separation of PL 1 teams from their clubs was a necessary step in a transition year, though it is something that will hopefully not have to happen again. A reduced number of grades in the Premier League and an increased level of responsibility for competing clubs in 2020 will facilitate this.

It's always difficult to get a large number of people and clubs to agree on many things. However, the one thing that all clubs come to a consensus on is that there exists an overwhelming desire for club hockey and for the competition to not run along similar lines to SWHL with indiscriminate promotion and relegation. The Board of Sydney Hockey is a competition committee, not an association, and is tasked to provide high quality competitions for players of all ability levels. The small changes to the competition structures for 2020 have been flagged for over twelve months and during this time many clubs who feel they may be affected have taken the time to meet with the Board or communicate via email. Their efforts have been much appreciated and it is heartening for clubs to be forward thinking, not just for themselves, but the good of the game. A disappointing element though is a very small number of clubs want club hockey only as long it it meets their individual needs and make very little effort to engage with the Board or other clubs. Each Board meeting is open, and the minutes are accessible as soon as they are ratified as accurate. I encourage all clubs to be involved and be empathetic for the greater good of the game.

I sincerely wish all clubs and all players all the best for the upcoming Christmas and New Year period. I hope that everyone will back up again for the 2020 season, as well inviting someone else to rejoin the game or introduce a new player to our great game.

Sydney Hockey Association Inc. Notes to the financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2019

Note 1: Statement of Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act New South Wales. The committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

a) Income Tax

No provision for income tax has been raised as the entity is exempt from income tax under Section 50-45 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

b) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

c) Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)

Leasehold improvements and office equipment are carried at cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

The depreciable amount of all PPE is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

Leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter of either the unexpired period of the lease or the estimated useful lives of the improvements.

d) Impairment of Assets

At each reporting date, the entity reviews the carrying values of its tangible and intangible assets to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have been impaired. If such an indication exists, the recoverable amount of the asset, being the higher of the asset's fair value less costs to sell and value in use, is compared to the asset's carrying value. Any excess of the asset's carrying value over its recoverable amount is expensed to the income statement.

e) Employee Benefits

Provision is made for the association's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. Employee benefits have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled.

f) Provisions

Provisions are recognised when the association has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reliably measured. Provisions are measured at the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at the end of the reporting period.

g) Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at-call with banks, other short-term highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less.

1 Statement of Accounting Policies (continued)

h) Revenue and Other Income

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest rate method, which for floating rate financial assets is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.

Grant and donation income is recognised when the entity obtains control over the funds, which is generally at the time of receipt.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

i) Leases

Leases of PPE, where substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to the ownership of the asset, but not the legal ownership, are transferred to the association, are classified as finance leases.

Finance leases are capitalised by recording an asset and a liability at the lower of the amounts equal to the fair value of the leased property or the present value of the minimum lease payments. Including any guaranteed residual values. Lease payments are allocated between the reduction of the lease liability and the lease interest expense for that period.

Leased assets are depreciated on a straight-line basis over the shorter of their estimated useful lives or the lease term.

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the periods in which they are incurred.

j) Goods and Services Tax

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the ATO is included with other receivables or payables in the statement of financial position.

Cash flows are presented in the cash flow statement on a gross basis, except for the GST component of investing and financing activities, which are disclosed as operating cash flows.

k) Comparative Figures

When required by Accounting Standards, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform to changes in presentation for the current financial year.

Opinion

We have audited the financial report of Sydney Hockey Association Inc, which comprises the assets and liabilities statement as at 30 September 2019, the income and expenditure statement, statement of movement in equity and statement of cash flows for the year then ended, and notes to the financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and the certification by the board of management on the annual statements giving a true and fair view of the financial position and performance of the Association.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial report gives a true and fair view of the financial position of the association as at 30 September 2019, and its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended in accordance with Associations Incorporation Act NSW 2009 & Association Incorporation Regulation 2016.

Basis for opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. We have also fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with the Code.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of matter – basis of accounting

We draw attention to Note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting. The financial report has been prepared to assist Sydney Hockey Association Inc to meet the requirements of the applicable legislation. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of management and those charged with governance for the financial report

The board is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial report in accordance with the financial reporting requirements of the applicable legislation and for such internal control as the board determines is necessary to enable the preparation and fair presentation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial report, the board is responsible for assessing the association's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters relating to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the board either intends to liquidate the association or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.
